Energy is a horizontal policy issue that influences directly or indirectly all other policy areas and consequently the whole socio-economic system. Given this assumption, (urban) public authorities play a key role as "facilitators" of the energy transformation process. They should coordinate approaches to formulate and plan low-carbon energy strategies. To achieve this, cities should set up energy units or empower those already established, mainly by providing them with tools and strategies but also giving them an effective role within the public administration. The key to success is a weaving together of individual low carbon energy strategies, creating an integrated framework of policies and programmes.

CitiEnGov aims to improve the capacity of public administrations to implement new energy planning strategies through a new comprehensive concept based on the:

- Acknowledgement of a political mandate for energy;
- Definition of a working group with roles and activities
- Real horizontal service made of experts about energy issues enabling the efficient realisation of the foreseen actions.
